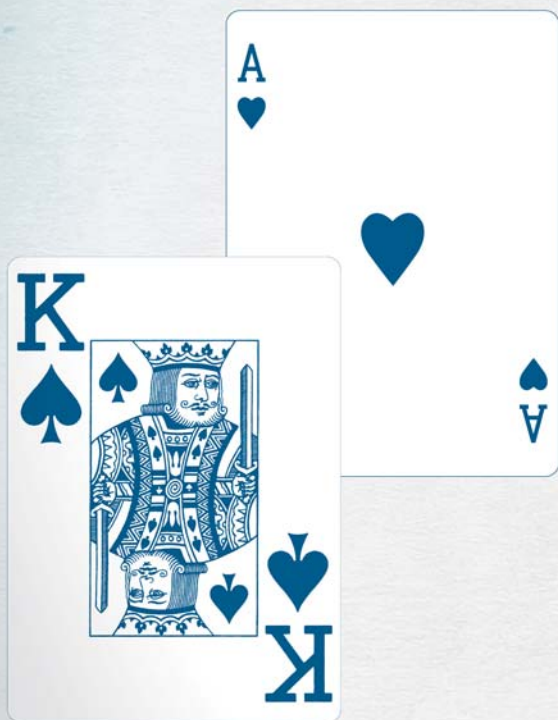

The Game

What you need to know before starting.

Each table may seat up to seven people, who alone decide how to play their hands. However, with their consent, players standing behind them can place bets in their boxes, but they may not make decisions.

The objective of the game is to reach or come as close as possible to 21 points without going over, if possible with just two cards.

VALUE OF THE CARDS

- Face cards: 10 points
- Ace: 1 or 11, at the player's discretion.
- The rest of the cards have their own numerical value.

BETS

- Wagers can only be placed with the Casino's chips, and never in cash or by call bet.
- You may change cash for chips at the table itself, provided the round has not begun.
- Remember that there is a placard at each table indicating minimum and maximum bets.
- The customer is solely responsible for the bets he or she places on the felt.

The Game Starts.

First, bets are placed in the rectangular space on the felt reserved for chips.

The dealer draws an upcard for each player, then deals a second card to each player but not to himself.

At this time, the players decide whether to draw more cards or stand, depending on the points they have so far.

A player who exceeds 21 loses and the dealer collects the chips wagered and the cards.

After all players have finished, the dealer plays according to the following rules:

- The dealer must draw cards until reaching a minimum of 17 points, and must stand when this occurs.
- The Ace counts as 11 points if 17 or more points are obtained with that value.
- However, if 21 is surpassed with that value, then the Ace counts as 1 point.

PAYMENT OF BETS

Players who have more points than the dealer without going over 21 win, in which case even-money is paid out, i.e. the same amount as the player's bet.

The Game

If the player has exactly 21 points with the two first cards, this is called blackjack (Ace + face card or 10) and the payout is 3 to 2 on the amount bet.



Blackjack always beats 21 points in a hand of more than two cards.

In case of a tie with the dealer, the play is voided and bets may then be changed or withdrawn.

INSURANCE

If the dealer's first card is an Ace, the players may insure against the possibility of dealer blackjack. Before the third card is dealt to the first player who draws it, the dealer offers you insurance.



In this case, the players may place bets on the insurance line in front of them for up to half the value of their original bet. As a minimum, this bet shall be equal to the value of the

smallest chip in the table's ante area. If the dealer has blackjack, he picks up the losing hands and pays the insurance 2 to 1. If he does not have blackjack, he collects the insurance bet and continues the game in accordance with the aforementioned rules.

PAIRS

If the first two cards drawn have the same value, the player may play each of them separately, placing a bet that is equal to the original wager.



If two aces are drawn, and the next card is a 10 or face card, this would be 21 points but not blackjack.

DOUBLE DOWN

If 9, 10 or 11 points are obtained with the first two cards, a player may double its bet and is entitled to draw just one more card.
